A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of United States Army Staff Sergeant Briand T. Williams and dedicating
2 a road in his memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, our nation's security continues to rely on patriotic men and women who put
4 their personal lives on hold in order to place themselves in harm's way to protect the
5 freedoms that all United States citizens cherish; and

6 WHEREAS, a native of Sparks, Georgia, Staff Sergeant Williams was a graduate of Cook
7 High School and was active with the Adel-Cook Recreational Department; and

8 WHEREAS, he lost his life in combat in Iraq protecting the freedoms that all United States
9 citizens cherish; and

10 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary accomplishments of
11 this distinguished Georgian be recognized by naming a road in his honor.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
13 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 76 in Cook County from 4th
14 Street in Adel to the Brooks County line is dedicated as the United States Army Staff
15 Sergeant Briand T. Williams Memorial Highway.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
17 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the United States Army Staff
18 Sergeant Briand T. Williams Memorial Highway.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
20 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the family of United States
21 Army Staff Sergeant Briand T. Williams and to the Department of Transportation.
