## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging local boards of education to ensure that each of its schools has an operational
- 2 wheelchair onsite at all times; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, on occasion the need arises to transport a student or staff member in a school
- 4 due to injury or illness; and
- 5 WHEREAS, there have been anecdotal incidents of school personnel utilizing regular chairs
- 6 in such instances; and
- 7 WHEREAS, it is essential that medical aid and assistance be received as soon as possible in
- 8 the event of injury or illness; and
- 9 WHEREAS, students and staff persons would greatly benefit from having access to a
- wheelchair in the event of injury or illness to transport such person as quickly as possible and
- 11 as safely as possible to medical aid.
- 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 13 the members of this body urge local boards of education to ensure that each of its schools has
- an operational wheelchair onsite at all times for purposes of transporting students or staff
- 15 persons in the event of temporary incapacity or physical illness or injury.
- 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that businesses, organizations, and individuals, including
- 17 parent-teacher organizations and public or private donors, are encouraged to donate
- wheelchairs to local boards of education for use in their schools for such purposes.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to local
- 21 boards of education.
