- 2 WHEREAS, Major General Tom Carden was appointed by Governor Kemp in January of

14 WHEREAS, he has held a number of key positions in the Army and Georgia Army National

- 15 Guard including Deputy Commanding General of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization's
- 16 Multi-National Division Southeast (Romania), the Georgia Army National Guard
- 17 Commanding General, chief of staff, deputy chief of staff for operations, and deputy chief
- 18 for personnel; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he commanded the 560th Battlefield Surveillance Brigade and the Georgia
- 20 Army National Guard's Recruiting and Retention Battalion and also served as the operations
- 21 officer for the 2nd Battalion, 121st Infantry Regiment and, in this capacity, he deployed to
- 22 Bosnia, Herzegovina, as part Operation Joint Forge; and
- 23 WHEREAS, in 2005, he deployed to Iraq with the 48th Infantry Brigade Combat Team as
- 24 part of Operation Iraqi Freedom; and
- 25 WHEREAS, his military decorations include the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star Medal, the
- 26 Meritorious Service Medal, the Army Commendation Medal, the Army Achievement Medal,
- 27 the Army Reserve Components Achievement Medal, the National Defense Service Medal,
- 28 the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, the Humanitarian Service Medal, the Armed Forces
- 29 Reserve Medal, the Combat Infantry Badge, and the Parachutist Badge; and
- 30 WHEREAS, in his position as Adjutant General, he is responsible for directing, coordinating,
- 31 organizing and stationing the Army and Air National Guards of the State of Georgia, the
- 32 Georgia State Defense Force, and federal and state civilians, ensuring their readiness to
- 33 perform state and national missions; and
- 34 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
- 35 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
