A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 18, 2016, as Georgia Association of Educators (GAE) Day at the
2 capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the GAE is the oldest organization in Georgia that represents school employees
4 in every public school district in Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, the GAE represents public school teachers, administrators, education support
6 personnel, retired educators, and college students and faculty; and

7 WHEREAS, the GAE supports efforts to protect the health and safety of all children and
8 public school employees; and

9 WHEREAS, the GAE advocates stalwartly for positive changes in public education and to
10 protect and expand the rights and benefits of all school employees; and

11 WHEREAS, the GAE works assiduously and untiringly to empower educators to make a
12 difference in the lives of children and improve Georgia's public schools; and

13 WHEREAS, the GAE continues to support efforts to attract and retain well qualified,
14 prepared educators to teach every child in Georgia's public schools in order to prepare
15 children for the jobs of tomorrow; and

16 WHEREAS, the GAE annually conducts a GAE Day at the capitol providing an opportunity
17 for members from every school district to discuss legislative priorities with members of the
18 Georgia General Assembly.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body recognize February 18, 2016, as GAE Day at the capitol and

21 convey all the accolades and appreciation possible to acknowledge the dedicated hard work
22 of every public school employee in Georgia.
