### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Rannell Caringus Brigham; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Rannell Caringus Brigham on February 26, 2024; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Rannell Caringus Brigham was born on October 18, 1976, and he received his  
5 early education in the Chatham County Schools System in Savannah, Georgia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, originally part of the Third Coast, he was united in love and marriage in 2004  
7 to his wife, Lakenya Holmes-Brigham, and in 2010, he returned to Savannah to support and  
8 empower his community; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he served for many years as a major advocate for families and youth with  
10 autism as well as played a major role in redeeming the soul of his community through music,  
11 healing, and restoration; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
13 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his  
14 family and friends were admired by others; and

15 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
16 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he  
17 made this world a better place in which to live; and

18 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Rannell Caringus Brigham will long be  
19 remembered for his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who  
20 had the great fortune of knowing him.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
22 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Rannell Caringus Brigham  
23 and express their deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
