- 3 WHEREAS, the University of West Georgia is a dynasty in the work of competitive
- 4 cheerleading, and that dynasty picked up one more title at the Universal Cheerleader
- 5 Association National Championship, the Division II championship; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the coed squad was the first among the UWG cheerleading teams to make

- one of America's Best Value Colleges, the University of West Georgia provides exceptional
