A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Mrs. Ashley MacDonald Callahan and dedicating an intersection in her memory;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Ashley MacDonald Callahan has long been recognized by the citizens of
4 this state for the vital role that she played in the teaching profession and her deep personal
5 commitment to the education of the students of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, a graduate of the University of Georgia, Mrs. Callahan devoted 16 years to
7 inspiring the future leaders of this state as a high school and middle school educator; and

8 WHEREAS, she made the subject of science come to life for her students by developing an
9 oceanography course which was used by several schools and by assisting with writing the
10 oceanography curriculum for the State of Georgia; and

12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Callahan was a dedicated professional who went above and beyond,
13 serving in leadership roles and working with students inside and outside of the classroom;

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
16 Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating an intersection in her memory.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
18 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 81 at Ozora Church Road
19 in Walton County is dedicated as the Ashley MacDonald Callahan Memorial Intersection.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
21 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Ashley MacDonald Callahan
22 Memorial Intersection.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
24 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
25 family of Mrs. Ashley MacDonald Callahan and to the Department of Transportation.
