- 13 civil rights movement in this country.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 15 the members of this body recognize December 1, 2018, as Mrs. Rosa L. Parks Day at the
- 16 state capitol.

- and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 19 public and the press.
