A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring and commending American Heritage Girls; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, American Heritage Girls (AHG) is currently chartered in every state except
3 Utah; and
- 4 WHEREAS, AHG has 33,485 national members in all 50 states, 1,232 troops nationally,
5 1,289 members in Georgia, and 50 troops in the State of Georgia; its purpose is to instill
6 spiritual and character development in young women; and
- 7 WHEREAS, on June 25, 2015, AHG and Trail Life USA signed a Memorandum of Ministry
8 Alliance, which is the highest form of relationship each organization can hold, and it was
9 approved by both boards; and by sharing skills, talents, knowledge, and common goals, both
10 groups will be able to empower and support their respective memberships in order to
11 accomplish great things in their communities while spreading the love of God to others; and
