- 3 WHEREAS, lissencephaly is a rare gene-linked brain malformation, causing the brain to
- 4 have less or no ridges and folds, making it appear smooth. It is estimated about 1 in 100,000
- 5 individuals are born with this condition; and
- 6 WHEREAS, people living with this condition may also suffer from hypertonia, epilepsy,
- 7 swallowing disorders, developmental delays, and more; and
- 8 WHEREAS, addressing the complex medical needs early in life is imperative to helping
- 9 families successfully care for their children at home. The need for more education,
- awareness, and support for families is desperately needed; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Lissencephaly Foundation Inc. is a nonprofit charitable organization that
- 12 supports these individuals through continued efforts of empowering families and educating
- 13 communities.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 15 the members of this body recognize September 8, 2020, as Lissencephaly Awareness Day
- 16 at the state capitol.
