- 1 Recognizing and commending William Anthony Hall for his distinguished military career;
- 2 and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, William Anthony Hall has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for
- 4 the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the
- 5 welfare of the citizens of the United States; and
- 6 WHEREAS, our nation's security continues to rely on patriotic men and women who put
- 7 their personal lives on hold in order to place themselves in harm's way to protect the
- 8 freedoms that all United States citizens cherish; and
- 9 WHEREAS, William served this nation with honor and distinction with the United States
- 10 Army over a 22-year career, retiring as a lieutenant colonel in 2005; and
- 11 WHEREAS, William received a Bachelor of Arts in commercial arts and advertising from
- 12 Mississippi State University in 1984 and was commissioned as a second lieutenant through
- 13 the Advanced Army ROTC Program in 1983; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he traveled widely throughout his military career, serving at military
- 15 installations within the United States and abroad, including assignments at Fort Campbell,
- 16 Kentucky; Herzo Base, Germany; Fort Sill, Oklahoma; the University of Missouri-Columbia;
- 17 and Schofield Barracks, Hawaii; and
- 18 WHEREAS, his most rewarding assignment was that of battalion commander, where he led
- an organization of 464 soldiers in peace time and during combat operations in Afghanistan,
- 20 supporting Operation Enduring Freedom; his unit played a vital role in establishing the
- 21 Provincial Reconstruction Team (PRT) Sites in Afghanistan, and his organizations conducted
- 22 more than 2,400 security missions, with no loss of life or limb during their deployment; and

23 WHEREAS, his military career culminated after a 12-month assignment at the Pentagon,

- 24 where he served as a special assistant to the Chief of Staff of the United States Army; and
- 25 WHEREAS, William is a highly decorated veteran, having received numerous awards,
- 26 including the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (with four Oak Leaf Clusters),
- 27 Army Commendation Medal (with one Oak Leaf Cluster), Army Achievement Medal (with
- 28 three Oak Leaf Clusters), the Parachutist Badge, and the Air Assault Badge; and
- 29 WHEREAS, after his military service ended, William moved on to earn a master's degree in
- 30 project management from Keller Graduate School of Business and was employed as a senior
- 31 consultant for a defense contractor for eight years; and
- 32 WHEREAS, he is an original member and co-founder of Ask Dad Incorporated, a nonprofit
- organization consisting of volunteer dads who serve communities in Southwest Atlanta; and
- 34 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
- 35 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and
- 36 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
- 37 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
- 38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 39 the members of this body recognize and commend William Anthony Hall and extend the
- 40 most sincere best wishes for his continued health and happiness.
