A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Chief John Mullin; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Chief John Mullin has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the
3 vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare
4 of the citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
6 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state, as evidenced
7 dramatically by his decades of superlative law enforcement service; and

8 WHEREAS, prior to his current post as chief of the Lawrenceville Police Department, he
9 served Forsyth County, Georgia, as director of the Code Enforcement, Animal Control, and
10 Park Rangers divisions, ensuring the protection and well-being of more than 250,000

13 graduation from the John Jay College of Criminal Justice, first working for nine years as part
14 of the Fulton County Police Department; and

16 remarkable patience and diplomacy, keen sense of vision, and sensitivity to the needs of the
17 citizens of this state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and
18 associates; and

19 WHEREAS, his inspiring commitment to the welfare of others is an outstanding example of
20 the positive effect law enforcement professionals have on the lives and well-being of others;

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that gratitude is expressed for the unique and
23 often unheralded contributions of local law enforcement professionals on behalf of the
24 citizens of this state.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
26 the members of this body commend the care, courage, sympathy, and selfless dedication
27 exhibited by Chief John Mullin in carrying out the difficult duties of his vocation and express
28 their utmost appreciation for having so purely and truly defined for others the meaning of
29 public servant.
