- 1 Recognizing Honorable Floyd Adams, Jr., and dedicating a bridge in his memory; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Honorable Floyd Adams, Jr., has long been recognized by the citizens of this
- 4 state for the vital role that he played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the
- 5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
- 7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
- 8 dramatically by his superlative service to the City of Savannah; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mayor Adams was born in Savannah on May 11, 1945, the beloved son of
- 10 Floyd "Pressboy" Adams, Sr., and Wilhelmina Anderson Adams; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he attended St. Anthony Catholic School, St. Pius X Catholic School, Brooklyn
- 12 College, and Armstrong State College; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mayor Adams took over his family's printing business, The Herald of
- 14 Savannah, Inc., and became a master printer and professional photographer and served as the
- 15 Herald of Savannah's publisher and president, which is now known as Savannah Herald; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he was elected as District One alderman for the City of Savannah in 1982, a
- position he held until 1991 when he was elected to serve as alderman-at-large for Post One;

- 19 WHEREAS, Mayor Adams was the first African American elected to a city-wide post in
- 20 Savannah and later made history again by being elected as the first African American mayor
- 21 for the city; and

22 WHEREAS, Mayor Adams' leadership and guidance were instrumental to numerous

- 23 organizations, including the United Way, Private Industry Council, Georgia Black Elected
- 24 Officials Association, National Black Council of Local Elected Officials, Savannah's Printers
- 25 Association, Savannah's Photography Association, the Savannah Branch of the NAACP,
- 26 Cloverdale Civic Improvement Association, and Prince Hall Masons; and
- 27 WHEREAS, he was recognized with numerous honors and accolades, including a Freedom
- 28 Fighter Award from the NAACP and 1996 Citizen of the Year by Omega Psi Phi Fraternity,
- 29 Mu Phi Chapter; and
- 30 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
- 31 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a bridge in his memory.
- 32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
- 33 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the bridge on Interstate 516 over West Bay Street in
- 34 Chatham County is dedicated as the Mayor Floyd Adams, Jr., Bridge.
- 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
- 36 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Mayor Floyd Adams, Jr.,
- 37 Bridge.
- 38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 39 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 40 family of Honorable Floyd Adams, Jr., and to the Department of Transportation.
