- 18 principal of an integrated Atlanta Public School high school when she accepted the
- 19 appointment at Bass High School, the school from which she retired in 1982; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Fredericka gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep
- 21 concern for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she
- demonstrated to her family and friends were admired by others; and
