A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Atlanta Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority,
2 Inc.; and for other purposes.

4 in 1924; and

5 WHEREAS, it was the first chapter established in Atlanta and in Georgia, the second in the
6 Southern region, and the nineteenth in the United States; and

7 WHEREAS, eleven young women from both Atlanta University and Spelman College were
8 inducted as charter members; and

9 WHEREAS, the chapter has provided significant leadership and has conducted public service
10 programs of distinction since it was established; and

11 WHEREAS, the Atlanta Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., is
12 participating in the 2018 Delta Days at the state capitol under the leadership of its president,
13 Camille Smith Zeigler; and

14 WHEREAS, Roslyn Harper, Ph.D., Linda Jordan, and Robbin Shipp serve as the chairs of
15 the Political Awareness and Involvement Committee; and

16 WHEREAS, Fran Calhoun and Preye Cobham serve as the chairs of the Social Action
17 Committee; and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
19 extraordinary chapter be appropriately recognized.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
21 the members of this body recognize and commend the Atlanta Alumnae Chapter of Delta
22 Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., for its superb service to the community, its participation in
