- 18 English Teacher of Excellence Award; and
- 19 WHEREAS, she has received a variety of grants to support her literacy and social-emotional
- 20 health initiatives in her school and community, increasing the number of bilingual books in
- 21 the school library by 85 percent; donating over \$4,500 worth of diverse, bilingual, and
- 22 inclusive books to the Gwinnett County Public Schools Book Mobile; and creating a book
- 23 gift program for students with learning disabilities and emotional/behavioral disorders; and
