## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and honoring February 12, 2019, as Korean American Day at the state capitol;
- 2 and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS on January 13, 1903, the arrival of 102 pioneer immigrants to the United States
- 4 initiated the beginning of Korean immigration to the United States; and
- 5 WHEREAS the first generation of Korean immigrants established a new home in a new land
- 6 through resilience, tenacious effort, and immense sacrifice, which became the bedrock for
- 7 their children and future generations of Korean Americans; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Korean Americans, like immigrants to the United States before and after them,
- 9 have taken root and thrived as a result of strong family ties, robust community support, and
- 10 countless hours of hard work; and
- 11 WHEREAS, members of the early Korean American community served with distinction in
- 12 the armed forces of the United States during World War I, World War II, and the conflict in
- 13 Korea; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Korean Americans have made significant political, cultural, social, and
- 15 economic contributions to the State of Georgia, the United States, and the global
- 16 marketplace; and
- 17 WHEREAS, more than 120,000 Korean Americans call Georgia home, and Korean is the
- 18 third most spoken language in the State of Georgia; and
- 19 WHEREAS, prominent leaders and organizations have helped the Korean American
- 20 community in Georgia to thrive, including the Korean American Foundation led by President
- 21 Michael Park, the Korean American Association of Greater Atlanta led by President Il Hong
- 22 Kim, the National Unification Advisory Council led by Eric Kim, the Federation of Korean

23 Associations Southeast led by Kang Sik Kim, the Korean Consulate of Atlanta led by the

- 25 Um, the many Korean American Trade Associations in Georgia, and others; and
- 26 WHEREAS, for their outstanding contributions to community service, civic engagement, and
- 27 cross-cultural education, we honor and thank Shreve Lee, Baik Kyu Kim, Chai Won Kim,
- 28 Councilman John Park, and Stephanie Cho for their steadfast support for the Korean
- 29 American community in Georgia; and
- 30 WHEREAS, Pastor Byeongcheol Han on behalf of the more than 500 Korean American
- 31 churches in Georgia served as Pastor of the Day; and
- 32 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the innumerable contributions of this
- 33 outstanding group of Americans be appropriately recognized.
- 34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 35 the members of this body recognize February 12, 2019, as Korean American Day at the state
- 36 capitol.

- and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 39 public and the press.
