## A RESOLUTION

1 Requesting the United States Congress to take immediate and significant action to invest in

2 the future of this great nation by funding infrastructure construction, maintenance, and repair;

3 and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, our nation is challenged to "build gleaming new roads, bridges, highways,

5 railways, and waterways all across our land . . . with American heart, and American hands,

6 and American grit"; and

WHEREAS, our nation's goals include \$200 billion in federal funding alone, new
investments in our neglected rural areas, increased decision-making authority at the local
level, and streamlined permitting of infrastructure projects; and

10 WHEREAS, such an injection of federal funding would spur at least \$1.5 trillion in11 additional infrastructure investments; and

12 WHEREAS, rural infrastructure is especially in need of modernization in order to buttress

13 the vitality of these heartland areas; and

WHEREAS, an investment in infrastructure is ultimately an investment in our nation's mostvaluable asset: its hard-working citizens.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that 17 the members of this body request that the United States Congress take immediate and 18 significant action to invest in the future of this great nation by funding infrastructure

19 construction, maintenance, and repair.

and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to
Georgia's congressional delegation.
