#### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Rothschild Leadership Academy; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Rothschild Leadership Academy was named after Maurice Rothschild, who  
3 served on the Muscogee County School Board for 21 years, and was first opened on  
4 October 6, 1968, as Rothschild Middle School; and
- 5 WHEREAS, it is the mission of Rothschild Leadership Academy to inspire and equip  
6 students in such a way that they may realize and achieve unlimited potential; and
- 7 WHEREAS, every teacher at Rothschild Leadership Academy engages each student in a  
8 caring and nurturing environment and reveres the quality of leadership, aiming to instill this  
9 quality within students by teaching them that leadership goes hand in hand with attitude, that  
10 a true leader is someone who uses their influence in order to help others accomplish set tasks  
11 or goals, and that leadership is a talent that anyone can develop; and
- 12 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this academy and its profound and  
13 positive influence on the lives of its students be appropriately recognized.

15 the members of this body recognize and commend Rothschild Leadership Academy for its  
16 contributions to the education and welfare of young people in this state.
