- 17 community of Portuguese speakers in Georgia regarding the importance of the United States
- 18 Census; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Lucas worked as the secretary of the Council of Brazilian Citizens in Atlanta,
- 20 the organization that manages the relationship between citizens of Brazil and the local
- 21 consulate general, and assisted the council's leadership with the logistics for the Annual
- 22 Brazilian Health Day in Marietta, Georgia; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Lucas, as the recipient of the prestigious Robert and Margaret Pastor Graduate
- 24 Assistant Fellowship, served the Carter Center as an electoral projects assistant, aiding the
- organization with its electoral expert mission in Bogotá, Colombia, in 2022; and
- 26 WHEREAS, Lucas, an enthusiast of international connections and African American history,
- 27 co-led the first mission trip of the historic Ebenezer Baptist Church, Dr. Martin Luther King
- 28 Jr.'s congregation, to South America (Rio de Janeiro, Brazil) in the summer of 2022. On that
- 29 occasion, 15 members of Ebenezer connected with Afro-Brazilian civic and social leaders
- 30 from Rio de Janeiro's City Hall, the Marielle Franco Institute, and Our Brazilian Church -
- 31 Baptist Church and conducted social work activities at Casa Semente, an NGO focused on
- 32 after school's programs; and

- remarkable and distinguished citizen be appropriately recognized.
