## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and honoring Greece and the Coordinated Effort of Hellenes (CEH) on the
- 2 sacred occasion of Greek Independence Day; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Greek Independence Day is a national holiday celebrated annually in Greece
- 4 on March 25, and the date commemorates the start of the War of Greek Independence in
- 5 1821, a war that led to the liberation of Crete and Greece from Turkish rule and ended nearly
- 6 400 years of oppression under the Ottoman Empire; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the governments and people of Greece and the United States are at the forefront
- 8 of efforts to advance freedom, democracy, peace, stability, and human rights and those
- 9 efforts and similar ideals have forged a close bond between the people of Greece and the
- 10 United States; and
- 11 WHEREAS, throughout the 20th Century, Greece was one of a few countries that allied with
- 12 the United States in every major international conflict; and
- WHEREAS, the cultures and political philosophies of Greece and the United States are
- 14 heavily influenced by one another, leading to a cross-cultural understanding between the two
- 15 countries and a history of cooperation on many important political, civic, and economic
- 16 issues affecting the lives of both country's citizens; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the Greeks, like the citizens of Georgia, possess a commitment to democratic
- 18 principles and values that manifest themselves in their everyday lives; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the Coordinated Effort of Hellenes is committed to fostering Greece's relations
- 20 with other countries and diligently strives to improve cooperation between many differing
- 21 countries; thus, their dedicated work and commitment to mutual respect and understanding
- between cultures enhances stability in their region of the world and it is only fitting and
- 23 proper that its outstanding achievements be appropriately recognized.
