A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on Tax Credits for Convenience Stores in Qualified
- 2 Low Income Census Tracts that Sell Produce; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, there is a decided lack of opportunity in many underprivileged areas to purchase
- 4 nutritional fresh produce; and
- 5 WHEREAS, convenience stores are the most common seller of food products in such areas;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, a monumental body of research clearly illustrates the importance of fresh
- 8 produce in a healthy and well-balanced diet; and
- 9 WHEREAS, convenience stores serve as the most obvious solution to this conundrum and
- 10 a committee should study options for tax credits for convenience stores in underprivileged
- areas that offer some minimum amount of produce for purchase merits careful study and
- 12 consideration.
- 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

14 (1) Creation of House study committee. There is created the House Study Committee

- on Tax Credits for Convenience Stores in Qualified Low Income Census Tracts that Sell
- 16 Produce.
- 17 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of seven members of the
- House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- 19 Representatives. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee as chairperson
- of the committee.
- 21 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 24 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- 25 may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.
- 28 (5) Allowances and funding. The legislative members of the committee shall receive
- the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia
- Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any
- 31 member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.
- Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the House of Representatives.
- 34 (6) **Report.**
- 35 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- 37 same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.

39 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for 40 proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C) 41 of this paragraph.

- (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with the Clerk of the House of Representatives.

- 46 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the
 47 House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu
 48 thereof.
- 49 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2024.
