A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Matthew Christopher "Matt" Littlefield; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
4 with the passing of Matthew Christopher "Matt" Littlefield on March 2, 2024; and

5 WHEREAS, Matthew Christopher "Matt" Littlefield was born on May 16, 1985, the beloved
6 son of Byron Willis "Mickey" Littlefield and Margaret Williamson Littlefield; and

7 WHEREAS, he attended Sandy Creek High School where he was a receiver on Sandy
8 Creek's standout football team; and

9 WHEREAS, he graduated from the University of Georgia; and

10 WHEREAS, he forged deep bonds with his family and friends and was so well liked that he
11 served as a groomsman 19 times and was known as Uncle Matt to dozens of children of
12 friends; and

13 WHEREAS, he proudly served as a registered lobbyist at the Georgia state capitol where he
14 also built lasting friendships; and

15 WHEREAS, his career as a lobbyist led him to work on major political campaigns, including
16 those of Herschel Walker's Senate campaign and Tyler Harper's campaign for Agriculture
17 Commissioner; and

18 WHEREAS, he was immensely proud of his family, sisters Susan-Elizabeth and Victoria,
19 beloved brother-in-law Philip, niece Mickey-Reese, and nephew Parker; and

20 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
21 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
22 family and friends were admired by others; and

23 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
24 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
25 made this world a better place in which to live; and

26 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, he will long be remembered for his love
27 of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great fortune of
28 knowing him.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
30 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Matthew Christopher
