- 19 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the bridge over Big Creek on U.S. 82 .7 miles from
- 20 Schlatterville and 3.1 miles from Hoboken West in Brantley County is renamed as the
- 21 Charles E. Hickox Memorial Bridge.
