- 20 WHEREAS, he was appointed as executive director of at the Association County
- 21 Commissioners of Georgia in May 2010; and
- WHEREAS, he worked diligently and conscientiously on behalf of Georgia's county officials
- 23 and their communities, with a focus on public policy and advocacy, leadership development,
- 24 civic and community engagement, and cost-efficient programs such as insurance and
- 25 retirement; and
- 26 WHEREAS, he retired in 2017 after 30 years of efficient and dedicated public service with
- 27 the Association County Commissioners of Georgia; and
- WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, remarkable patience and
- 29 diplomacy, keen sense of vision, and sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this state
- 30 earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and
