A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March, 2018, as Sudden Unexplained Death in Childhood (SUDC) Awareness
- 2 Month at the state capitol; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Sudden Unexplained Death in Childhood (SUDC) is the sudden and unexpected
- 4 death of a child over the age of 12 months which remains unexplained after a thorough case
- 5 investigation is conducted, including performance of a complete autopsy, examination of the
- 6 death scene, and review of the child's medical history; and
- 7 WHEREAS, each year there are approximately 400 cases of SUDC in the United States in
- 8 children between the ages of one and 19, including more than 200 children under the age of
- 9 five who die without any clear cause or explanation; and
- 10 WHEREAS, while less common than Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS), which occurs
- before a child's first birthday, SUDC is an important health concern deserving of increased
- 12 public awareness and research; and
- 13 WHEREAS, SUDC is the fifth leading cause of death among toddlers and, at the present
- 14 time, there is no way to prevent SUDC as its cause is unknown; and
- 15 WHEREAS, it is hoped that future research will identify means by which SUDC can be
- 16 prevented; and
- 17 WHEREAS, we recognize the dedicated efforts of organizations such as the SUDC
- 18 Foundation, medical professionals, and volunteers who are working to better understand the
- 19 causes of sudden unexplained death, improve the health of infants and children, and provide
- 20 much needed hope and support for those families grieving the heartbreaking sudden
- 21 unexplained death of a child; and

- 23 opportunity to honor the memory of young lives that ended too soon, show encouragement
- 24 and support for the families and loved ones forever devastated by their loss, and increase
- 25 public awareness of SUDC and the ongoing search for answers.
- 26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 27 the members of this body recognize March, 2018, as Sudden Unexplained Death in
- 28 Childhood (SUDC) Awareness Month at the state capitol.
- 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 30 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 31 public and the press.
