A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Louis C. Graziano; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, coming from a family of cosmetologists, Louis C. Graziano has worked in the
3 State of Georgia for 65 of his 80 years as a licensed hairdresser; at 97 years old, he is
4 Georgia's oldest active cosmetologist; and

5 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
6 States Army, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans during World War
7 II; and

8 WHEREAS, during his service, Louis was placed in charge of the Little Red Schoolhouse
9 in Reims, France, where he witnessed firsthand the signing of the German Instrument of
10 Surrender; he is the last living survivor who witnessed the signing; and

11 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentleman has given inspiration to many through his high
12 ideals, morals, and deep concern for his fellow citizens, and he possesses the vast wisdom
13 which only comes through experience and the strength of character which is achieved
14 through overcoming the many challenges of life; and

15 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
16 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
18 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body recognize and commend Louis C. Graziano for both his service and

21 his dedication to cosmetology and extend the most sincere best wishes for continued health
22 and happiness.
