- 13 WHEREAS, he cherished his family and was a bedrock on whom his loved ones could
- always count, and he thoroughly enjoyed being a grandfather as much as anything on earth;

- 17 his business school class. He also earned a J.D. from the University of Tennessee College

- 20 Army Judge Advocate General's Corps, West Germany, followed by 40 years of private

- 27 1993, was vice chairman of Common Cause Georgia, served on the University of Tennessee
- 28 College of Law Alumni Advisory Council, and was a member of the Auburn Alumni
- 29 Association Board of Directors; and
- 30 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Wyc will long be remembered for his love
- 31 of family and friendship, and this loyal gentleman and friend will be missed by all who had
- 32 the great fortune of knowing him.
