A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Police Chief Mark Revenew; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Mark Revenew served with honor and distinction for 33 years with the Pooler
3 Police Department where he was promoted to police chief in 2010 and has been recently
4 appointed chief of the Savannah Police Department; and

5 WHEREAS, he is an honest and dedicated public servant who strives for excellence in all
6 of his endeavors and whose primary concern is the welfare and safety of the citizens of
7 Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, he is highly regarded by the citizens of his community and by state and local
9 government officials as a man of unquestioned integrity and dedication to the administration
10 of justice and sound principles of law enforcement; and

11 WHEREAS, this spirited law enforcement professional has exhibited extraordinary devotion
12 to duty, outstanding loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all of his
13 duties, whether serving as chair of the Chatham County 911 Advisory Board, as secretary of
14 the Georgia Board of Public Safety, or as adjunct professor of criminal justice at Saint Leo
15 University, his alma mater; and

16 WHEREAS, Police Chief Revenew's efficient and effective commitment to excellence is
17 undeniable and has been recognized and appreciated by his peers and all of those who have
18 the great fortune of knowing him; and

19 WHEREAS, his inspiring commitment to the welfare of others is an outstanding example of
20 the positive effect law enforcement professionals have on the lives and well-being of others;

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that gratitude is expressed for the unique and
23 often unheralded contributions of local law enforcement professionals on behalf of the
24 citizens of this state.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
26 the members of this body commend the care, courage, sympathy, and selfless dedication
27 exhibited by Police Chief Mark Renew in carrying out the difficult duties of his vocation
28 and express their utmost appreciation for having so purely and truly defined for others the
29 meaning of public servant.
