- 5 commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

- 9 WHEREAS, she first took her place on the political stage in 1984 when she was chosen as
- 10 a presidential delegate for candidate Reverend Jesse Jackson at the Democratic National
- 11 Convention held in San Francisco, California; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in 1997, Representative Thomas was elected to the Atlanta City Council, where
- she was responsible for passing an Affordable Housing Policy Bill, obtaining \$4.9 million
- 14 for Atlanta Green Space Conservation, and serving as a major stakeholder in community
- 15 efforts to secure the Historic Westside Revitalization Project; and
- 16 WHEREAS, during her time with the Georgia General Assembly, she has championed issues
- 17 such as women's reproductive health, education reform, living wages, racial profiling,
- 18 economic development, access to health care, and senior issues; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Representative Thomas has served as the catalyst for several landmark pieces
- 20 of legislation, including the Rape Shield Statute, which prevents past sexual history from
- 21 being included in rape trials, and the Hit and Run Bill, which was passed and signed by the
- 22 Governor in May 2019; and

- 25 Development and Tourism, and Congressional Reapportionment; and
- 26 WHEREAS, a dedicated member of her community, Representative Thomas is the founder
- 27 of the Greater Vine City Opportunities Program Inc., which provides youth and family
- 28 enrichment and educational opportunities for high-risk urban youth throughout Atlanta's
- 29 westside; and
- 30 WHEREAS, her recent purchase of the historic English Avenue Elementary School, which
- 31 will be converted into a multi-million dollar, state-of-the-art global community center with
- 32 75 units of affordable housing and community gardens, stands as further testament to her
- 33 commitment to the people of this state; and
- 34 WHEREAS, Representative Thomas has served the Georgia House of Representatives with
- 35 honor and distinction, and her vision and unyielding commitment will be sorely missed upon
- 36 the occasion of her retirement; and
- 37 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
- 38 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
