A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Marshall Rancifer; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Marshall Rancifer was born on August 13, 1956, in Chicago, Illinois, and came
- 3 to Atlanta with his parents in 1957, where he attended E. R. Carter Elementary School; and
- 4 WHEREAS, as he grew to adulthood, Marshall fell into a troubled life, developing a drug
- 5 addiction and, in 1997, he committed himself to St. Jude's Recovery Center for treatment;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, after recovering from his drug addiction, Marshall made a promise to himself
- 8 to help those in need, and in 2009 he acquired state certification to perform HIV testing; he
- 9 now travels across Atlanta testing individuals where other state testers infrequently venture;
- 10 and
- WHEREAS, since 1998, he has helped 2,872 people get off the streets and has aided more
- 12 than 1,000 primarily homeless drug addicts gain access to detox treatment programs; each
- 13 year, Marshall and his wife Lisa distribute some 10,000 condoms, dental dams, and female
- 14 condoms to those in need; and
- 15 WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Marshall and his wife went from
- 16 feeding 600 people to 1,800 weekly, and they distributed nearly 3,200 flyers to warn the
- 17 city's unsheltered population about the virus; their ongoing work to serve the most vulnerable
- 18 populations in Atlanta comes from their hearts and out of their own pockets; and
- 19 WHEREAS, through the work and leadership of Marshall and Lisa, the Justice for All
- 20 Coalition provides free HIV and hepatitis C testing, hot meals, sack lunches, IDs, MARTA
- 21 transportation, clothes, sleeping bags, blankets, shoes, socks, air mattresses, tents, chemical
- 22 hand warmers, and more to those in need; and
