## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending J. Mark Burkhalter upon his nomination as the United States

- 2 Ambassador to Norway; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, J. Mark Burkhalter is a distinguished member of the Johns Creek community
- 4 and a native son of the State of Georgia, born in Atlanta and raised in unincorporated Fulton

5 County, now known as the City of Johns Creek; and

6 WHEREAS, he graduated from Milton High School and earned two bachelor's degrees from

7 the University of Georgia, where he served as president of the International Relations Club

8 and as chair of the University's Model United Nations Delegation, leading the organization

- 9 to two national titles; and
- 10 WHEREAS, following graduation, he served on the legislative staff of Congressman Newt
- 11 Gingrich, representing Georgia's Sixth Congressional District at the United States Capitol,
- 12 and then returned to Georgia where he began a successful career in real estate development
- 13 as principal of Burkhalter Realty and Akin Properties; and

14 WHEREAS, he was elected to the Georgia House of Representatives in 1992 at the age of

15 31, where he served continuously for 18 years representing the citizens of District 41, one

16 of the largest state House districts of its time, and then District 50, encompassing the

- 17 boundaries of the City of Johns Creek; and
- 18 WHEREAS, during his 18 years in the Georgia House of Representatives, Mr. Burkhalter 19 led the charge that created the City of Johns Creek, extended the hotel/motel fee that paved 20 the way for Mercedez-Benz Stadium, and continually strived to be a good steward of 21 taxpayer dollars; and

- 22 WHEREAS, while in the General Assembly, Mr. Burkhalter served as a member on several
- 23 committees, including Legislative and Congressional Reapportionment, Rules, Economic
- 24 Development, Public Utilities and Telecommunications, and many others; and
- 25 WHEREAS, he served as Administration Floor Leader, Speaker Pro Tempore, and Speaker
- 26 of the House of Representatives under Governor Sonny Perdue, making him one of the few
- 27 Georgians in history to rise to that high office; and
- 28 WHEREAS, during his tenure as Speaker Pro Tempore, he sponsored significant and historic
- 29 legislation, including HB 1321 creating the City of Johns Creek, thereby creating a paradigm
- 30 shift in how the region functions and thus changing the face of the greater Atlanta
- 31 metropolitan area in perpetuity; and
- 32 WHEREAS, serving as Speaker of the House during his resignation from the Georgia
- 33 General Assembly in 2010, he then joined the international law firm, Dentons, as Senior
- 34 Advisor in Public Policy and Regulation practice; and
- WHEREAS, he further served on the State Transportation Board as the 6th CongressionalRepresentative from 2015 to 2019; and
- WHEREAS, on May 15, 2020, President Donald Trump nominated Mr. Burkhalter to serve
  as the United States Ambassador to Norway; and
- 39 WHEREAS, it is abundantly proper and fitting that the accomplishments of this remarkable
- 40 and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
  the members of this body commend J. Mark Burkhalter for his efficient, effective, unselfish,
  and dedicated public service to both the United States of America and the State of Georgia
  and extend sincere best wishes for continued success.
