A RESOLUTION

- 1 Supporting access to in-vitro fertilization in the State of Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, millions of Americans and citizens of the State of Georgia have struggled to
- 3 achieve pregnancy and have children; and
- 4 WHEREAS, among the fertility treatments available today, in-vitro fertilization has been
- 5 proven to be a safe and effective way to assist those struggling to conceive, thereby making
- 6 the dream of parenthood a reality for many; and
- 7 WHEREAS, in-vitro fertilization is additionally used to preserve fertility for patients with
- 8 cancer and other medical conditions, prevent generational transmission of disease, and allow
- 9 for future family building; and
- WHEREAS, 5,167 embryo-transfer procedures and 2,914 pregnancies occurred in 2021
- 11 using in-vitro fertilization; and
- WHEREAS, despite the tangible benefits of in-vitro fertilization, access to the treatment in
- 13 a neighboring state was recently threatened by that state's Supreme Court; and

14 WHEREAS, there should be no question that in-vitro fertilization will remain available in

- 15 the State of Georgia.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 17 the members of this body support access to in-vitro fertilization procedures within the State
- 18 of Georgia in recognition of the treatment's role in facilitating the joys of childbirth and
- 19 parenthood.
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 21 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 22 public and the press.
