3 with the passing of Robert Jordan, a lifetime Fayetteville resident and entrepreneur; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Robert Jordan was the proud operator of Jordan Sales & Salvage, which has

- 6 WHEREAS, he had a stellar reputation and he was so esteemed in his community that  
7 aspiring political candidates sought his advice on whether or not to run for local office or any
