- 1 Recognizing and commending Mallory Harris for her scholarship, public outreach, volunteer
- work, and continued political advocacy efforts; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Mallory Harris was born and raised in Dunwoody, Georgia, where she
- 4 graduated high school as Valedictorian; and
- 5 WHEREAS, her academic pursuits took her to the University of Georgia as a Foundation
- 6 Fellow, where she earned undergraduate degrees in both math and computation; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Mallory was the recipient of the 2017 Goldwater Scholarship, the most
- 8 prestigious undergraduate award for research in the STEM disciplines, and has been
- 9 recognized for her work on disease forecasting, which was conducted in the Center for the
- 10 Ecology of Infectious Disease; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Mallory has served as a volunteer for educational outreach programs in
- 12 Athens-Clarke County, including MathCounts, Barrow Elementary School's math and
- 13 reading intervention program, and the Athens all-girls math team; and
- 14 WHEREAS, her political advocacy has centered around her pursuit of sensible gun safety
- 15 legislation, and she has organized multiple rallies in Athens, Georgia, to showcase opposition
- 16 to the guns on campus bill of 2017; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Mallory regularly coordinates tabling events and hosts meetings to foster
- 18 discussion on gun violence prevention in her community; and
- 19 WHEREAS, she helped to drive 14,873 calls against guns on campus to the Governor's office
- 20 in 2017 and then collected comments from students across the state and delivered them to
- 21 legislators during Moms Demand Action's 2018 Advocacy Day; and

22 WHEREAS, Mallory served as a featured college student speaker in Liberty Plaza, where

- 23 she spoke to a crowd of more than 1,800 Georgians regarding gun violence in America; and
- 24 WHEREAS, she was the lead organizer of the Athens, Georgia, March for Our Lives event,
- 25 which attracted over 600 attendees and included voter registration, election information, gun
- safety discussion, and candidate speeches, and spotlighted the intersections of gun violence,
- 27 racial violence, school safety, suicide prevention, and domestic violence; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Mallory Harris is becoming a name to remember through her academic success
- 29 and political advocacy; and
- 30 WHEREAS, the public has been moved and inspired by her work, and it is abundantly fitting
- 31 and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this exemplary citizen be further
- 32 recognized.
- 33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 34 the members of this body recognize and commend the efforts of Mallory Harris, an
- 35 outstanding academic product of Georgia's public education system who has excelled in her
- 36 STEM field at UGA, for her continued commitment to political advocacy.
