18 WHEREAS, a lifelong resident of Liberty County, Georgia, Ms. Helen Way Scott is a person  
19 of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for integrity, intelligence,  
20 fairness, and kindness; and

21 WHEREAS, she has witnessed a dramatic change in the world over the course of her lifetime  
22 and we salute her contribution to its progress by her own hard work and good citizenship;

24 WHEREAS, by the example Ms. Scott has made of her life, she makes this world a better  
25 place in which to live, and it is only fitting and proper that she be appropriately recognized  
26 during this very special and memorable time of her life.
