A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Republican Leadership for Georgia organization; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Republican Leadership for Georgia is the preeminent Republican leadership
4 program in the State of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, the Coverdell Leadership Institute and the Republican Leadership for Georgia
6 (RLG) programs have produced 477 Republican leaders in the past 21 years; and

7 WHEREAS, alumni of the RLG program have gone on to invest in their communities
8 through leadership roles as elected local, state, and federal officials; and

9 WHEREAS, current and past members have committed themselves to the protection and
10 promotion of Republican values and principles; and

11 WHEREAS, the late Senator Paul D. Coverdell, an icon of Georgian statesmanship, stated
12 that the RLG mission is to fill the ranks of Georgia's Republicans with trained leaders: people
13 who are committed to the tradition of full participation in the political process, people who
14 believe in Republican principles, and people who are willing to be or to support candidates
15 and serve as state or local appointees who will work at building the party's success at the
16 grassroots level; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the manifold contributions of this
18 outstanding program and its extraordinary members be appropriately recognized.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body recognize and commend the phenomenal group of Georgians who
21 have committed themselves to protect and promote Republican principles and values as
22 members of the 2018 Republican Leadership for Georgia Class.
