## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging all owners and operators of Georgia's self-service gasoline stations to implement
- 2 policies and practices to better assist disabled or mobility-impaired individuals who cannot
- 3 dispense their own gasoline; and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, disabled or mobility-impaired drivers may require assistance when dispensing
- 5 gasoline; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the late Henry "Wayne" Howard, who represented Georgia's 124th District in
- 7 the House of Representatives, championed legislation to encourage owners and operators of
- 8 self-service gasoline stations to have an operational telephone number that a disabled or
- 9 mobility-impaired driver can call to request assistance; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Representative Howard was very passionate about assisting and addressing the
- unmet needs of disabled or mobility-impaired drivers and introduced legislation during the
- 12 2019-2020 and 2021-2022 legislative sessions in an effort to create solutions to this problem;

- 14 WHEREAS, Representative Howard collaborated with Department of Agriculture
- 15 Commissioner Gary Black to create a decal with a blank space to be filled in with an

operational telephone number of the gasoline station so that disabled or mobility-impaired

- drivers may call to receive assistance at the pump; and
- 18 WHEREAS, to honor and continue Representative Howard's work, we encourage all owners
- and operators of Georgia's self-service gas stations to affix the decal to their gasoline pumps
- and to include on such decal their station's operational telephone number.
- 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 22 the members of this body urge all owners and operators of Georgia's self-service gasoline
- 23 stations to implement policies and practices to better assist disabled or mobility-impaired
- 24 individuals who cannot dispense their own gasoline.
- 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 27 public and the press.
