A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Representative Nikki Randall; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Representative Nikki Randall, a lifelong resident of Macon, Georgia, is the
3 beloved daughter of the Honorable William C. and Laretta Fults Randall and a
4 third-generation elected official; and
- 5 WHEREAS, she graduated from Bibb County Schools and received a bachelor's degree in
6 business administration with a concentration in marketing from Tennessee State University
7 in Nashville and a master's degree in public health from Mercer University School of
8 Medicine; and
- 9 WHEREAS, in 1999, she became the first African American female elected to the Georgia
10 General Assembly from Middle Georgia and is currently the only female representative in
11 all of the Middle Georgia area and the chair of the Bibb County Legislative Delegation and
12 the Georgia Legislative Women's Caucus; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Representative Randall serves on the Judiciary Non-civil, Health and Human
14 Services, Ethics, and Rules committees; after only five years of service, she was appointed
15 chair of the Interstate Cooperation Committee, which makes her the youngest committee
16 chair ever appointed; and she has served in numerous leadership positions while a member
17 of the House, including secretary and vice chair of the House Democratic Caucus; and
- 18 WHEREAS, for her admirable work, she was awarded Legislator of the Year in 2001; and
- 19 WHEREAS, she is affiliated with the Legislative Women's Caucus, Georgia's WIN List,
20 Georgia Legislative Black Caucus, NOBEL Women, and the National Black Caucus of State
21 Legislators Health Round Table; and

22 WHEREAS, Representative Randall is currently a governmental and community affairs
23 consultant and has served in many professional capacities, which include marketing and
24 public relations director at Associated Enterprises, assistant human resources director at the
25 Georgia Music Hall of Fame, employment services case manager at the Bibb County DFCS,
26 assistant legislative director at the Georgia Nursing Home Association, regional field
27 coordinator for the 1998 Barnes for Governor campaign, regional director of the Democratic
28 Party of Georgia, and regional marketing and community relations director at UHS-Pruitt
29 Corporation; and

30 WHEREAS, she is a distinguished alumna of Leadership Macon, Leadership Georgia, Bibb
31 County Democratic Women, Bibb County Democratic Executive Committee, Women's
32 Political Organization, Democratic Party of Georgia State Committee, and Alpha Kappa
33 Alpha Sorority; and

34 WHEREAS, while not serving at the capitol, she enjoys singing in her church's choir,
35 reading, mentoring rising political leaders, and volunteering with senior and youth
36 organizations; and

37 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this body recognize and commend the
38 remarkable selflessness and dedication of this incredible Georgian and express their gratitude
39 for her 17 years of service.

40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
41 the members of this body recognize Representative Nikki Randall, commend her for her
42 tireless service to the State of Georgia, and wish her enormous success in her future
