#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Lois Thornley Hay; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Lois Thornley Hay has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the  
3 vital role that she played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the welfare of  
4 the citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, she was elected Tax Commissioner in Newton County, Georgia, to fill the  
6 unexpired term of her husband, S. M. Hay, who resigned to enter the United States Army Air  
7 Corps in 1942; and

8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hay was an accomplished musician and president of the Georgia  
9 Federation of Women's Clubs, and she worked with UNICEF; and

10 WHEREAS, she diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,  
11 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state; and

12 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
13 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
15 the members of this body recognize and commend Lois Thornley Hay for her commitment  
16 and dedication to her community and the State of Georgia.
