18 years; and

19 WHEREAS, Layton Hayes has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal
20 adroitness, and personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and

21 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this
22 bright and promising young citizen.
