5 of jobs in our economy and are viewed as key to the economic recovery of the State of

6 Georgia and the nation; and

WHEREAS, entrepreneurs and small businesses can face many obstacles that must be
overcome in order to succeed, such as access to capital and markets; however, one of the
biggest obstacles to the success of entrepreneurs and small businesses can be government
itself; and

11 WHEREAS, entrepreneurs and small businesses can create a product or service that will take

12 off if they can get it to market, but they find complying with government requirements to be

WHEREAS, there is a need to focus attention on ensuring that government is not animpediment to the success of entrepreneurs and small businesses; and
