### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending REACH scholar Queen Riley; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, a gifted student at Berrien Middle School, Queen Riley has been recognized for  
3 her superlative achievement and been selected to participate in the REACH scholarship  
4 program; and
- 5 WHEREAS, starting in eighth grade, a student must display high commitment and  
6 intelligence, maintain a GPA of at least 2.5 in their core courses, and demonstrate good  
7 behavior and attendance throughout middle and high school; and
- 8 WHEREAS, upon graduation from high school, students who successfully complete the  
9 program are awarded \$10,000 that can be used to pay the cost of attendance at a two- or  
10 four-year Georgia REACH eligible institution; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Queen has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal adroitness,  
12 and personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and
- 13 WHEREAS, a proper quality education for the young people of this state is the single most  
14 important objective of the General Assembly, and Queen has shown by academic

15 accomplishment that the pursuit and attainment of scholastic success are within the reach of  
16 the students in this state; and

17 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this  
18 bright and promising young citizen.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body heartily commend REACH scholar Queen Riley and express their  
21 most sincere best wishes for continued academic success.
