A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing Women's Golf Day in the State of Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the number of women playing and enjoying golf in Georgia is increasing at a
3 rapid pace; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the popularity of golf among Georgia women is at an all-time high and still
5 climbing; and
- 6 WHEREAS, according to the National Golf Foundation, 23 percent of all golfers are women;
7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, June 6 shall forever be known annually in the State of Georgia as Women's
9 Golf Day.
- 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
11 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the members of this body:
- 12 (1) Designate June 6 of each year as Women's Golf Day in the State of Georgia; and

13 (2) Respectfully request the Governor to issue annually a proclamation recognizing June
14 6 in the State of Georgia as Women's Golf Day and call upon the people in the State of
15 Georgia to observe the day with appropriate programs and activities.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
17 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to
18 Governor Brian Kemp and the public and press.
