14 three remarkable children, Cynthia, Deborah, and Randall; seven wonderful grandchildren,

17 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
18 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
19 family and friends were admired by others; and

21 his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great
22 fortune of knowing him.
