A RESOLUTION

- 1 Celebrating the birth of Mitchell Adam Kaye, III; and for other purposes.

15 Maziar. Grandfather and former State Representative Mitchell Kaye held Mak during the

18 great-grandfathers Elliott Kaye and Donald Lind, of Blessed Memory, respectively; and

19 WHEREAS, grandmothers Amy Kaye and Amy Sue Maziar were in attendance as were
20 great-grandparents Ellen Kaye, Lynda Lind, Milton "Butch" Frank, III, and Sherry and Harry
21 Maziar, along with many other relatives and friends; and

22 WHEREAS, other Shluchim, or emissaries of the Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem Mendel
23 Schneerson, of Righteous Memory, in attendance included Rabbis Zalman Charytan, Chaim
24 Schwartz, Chaim Markovits, and Shmuel Wolf; and
