- 22 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Charlie D. Rodgers Memorial
- 23 Highway.

- and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 26 family of Mr. Charlie D. Rodgers and to the Department of Transportation.
