A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Charlotte Cook for her outstanding service with the armed forces of the United
2 States and recognizing February 19, 2019, as Women Veterans Day at the state capitol; and
3 for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Charlotte Cook honorably served in the United States Army Reserve and the
5 United States Air Force (USAF) for 13 years; and

6 WHEREAS, during her military service, Charlotte worked as an Administrative Specialist
7 with the United States Army Reserve for five years, before switching branches and enlisting
8 in the USAF in 1985; in the USAF, Charlotte worked as an Inventory Administrative
9 Specialist and was stationed at Lowry Air Force Base in Colorado, Osan Air Force Base in
10 Korea, and Norton Air Force Base in California; and

11 WHEREAS, Charlotte earned several degrees while in the USAF, including associate
12 degrees in logistics management and liberal arts and a bachelor's degree in business
13 management; and

14 WHEREAS, she played on the USAF softball team from 1985 to 1993 and coached softball
15 at Riverdale Parks and Recreation and Mundy Mills High School; and

16 WHEREAS, after discharge, Charlotte moved to Georgia and worked at the post office as
17 a city carrier before retiring in 2007; and

18 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentlewoman has given inspiration to many through her high
19 ideals, morals, and deep concern for her fellow citizens, and she possesses the vast wisdom
20 which only comes through experience and the strength of character which is achieved
21 through overcoming the many challenges of life; and

22 WHEREAS, Charlotte served with honor and distinction, and her vision and unyielding
23 commitment to her country and community have set the standard for public service.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body commend Charlotte Cook for her outstanding service with the
26 armed forces of the United States and recognize February 19, 2019, as Women Veterans Day
27 at the state capitol.
