## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring Sheriff Roger D. Garrison; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Sheriff Roger D. Garrison, born in Habersham County, Georgia, graduated from
- 3 Reinhardt University with a bachelor's degree in business and from Columbus State
- 4 University with a master's degree in public administration; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Sheriff Garrison began his law enforcement career with the Canton Police
- 6 Department, joined the Cherokee Sheriff's Office in 1981, and became a State Ranger with
- 7 the Georgia Department of Natural Resources in 1983; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was elected Sheriff of Cherokee County in 1992, serving until December 31,
- 9 2016, making him the longest serving sheriff in Cherokee County history; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Sheriff Garrison increased the training requirements of the deputies to double
- 11 the standards mandated by the State of Georgia and required command staff officers to
- 12 receive 60 hours of executive training annually; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Sheriff Garrison increased the agency's number of law enforcement instructors,
- many of whom hold specialized certifications, to more than 60 and created a multiagency
- 15 training program to ensure all law enforcement officers serving inside Cherokee County
- 16 receive the same quality instruction regardless of jurisdiction; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Sheriff Garrison increased the education level of the Cherokee Sheriff's Office
- 18 by providing 110 officers with the opportunity to complete the Professional Management
- 19 Program through the Law Enforcement Command College, and through a partnership with
- 20 Reinhardt University, more than 60 officers completed a bachelor's degree and 26 officers
- 21 completed a master's degree in public administration at Columbus State University through
- 22 the Law Enforcement Command College; and

23 WHEREAS, Sheriff Garrison is a 1996 graduate of the FBI National Academy and a

- 24 graduate of the FBI Law Enforcement Executive Development Program, the National
- 25 Sheriff's Institute, and the Regional Leadership Institute in Atlanta, and he holds an
- 26 Executive Certification from the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Sheriff Garrison currently serves as the Board Chairman of the Peace Officers'
- 28 Annuity and Benefit Fund, on the Board of Corrections, and on the Executive Board of the
- 29 Atlanta High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area; and
- 30 WHEREAS, Sheriff Garrison has been involved in civic activities for the past 20 years,
- 31 serving as a board member of the American Cancer Society and as a member of the Chamber
- 32 of Commerce, Cherokee Council on Child Abuse, Cherokee Multi-Agency Narcotics Squad,
- 33 Georgia Trend 40 under 40, A-Day for Reinhardt, and the Fulton County Courthouse
- 34 Security Task Force; and
- 35 WHEREAS, Sheriff Garrison has raised \$475,122 for Sheriff Roger Garrison Charities to
- 36 benefit local charities, including Meals on Wheels, Boys and Girls Club, Cherokee CASA,
- 37 and the Anna Crawford Children's Center; and
- 38 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
- 39 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
- 40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 41 the members of this body honor Sheriff Roger D. Garrison for his effective and dedicated
- 42 public service to his community and the State of Georgia.
