A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Guy J. Camuso Jr.; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Guy J. Camuso Jr. was born on December 12, 1942, in Boston, Massachusetts,
3 and he graduated from Briarcliff High School in Atlanta, Georgia, where he was recognized
4 as part of the First Team All-DeKalb County for his football prowess; and

5 WHEREAS, he matriculated at Eastern Kentucky University for one year before transferring
6 to the University of Georgia, graduating in 1967 with distinguished military honors and
7 earning commission in the United States Army as a second lieutenant; and

8 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty for three years,
9 including tours in Europe with the 24th Infantry Division and in Vietnam with the 23rd
10 Infantry Division Light from 1968 to 1969, and was honorably discharged at the rank of
11 captain; and

12 WHEREAS, in recognition of his distinguished service, he earned two Bronze Stars, two
13 Army Commendation medals, and the Vietnam Campaign Medal with five campaign stars;

15 WHEREAS, in 1988, he was accepted into the John Marshall Law School in Atlanta,
16 graduating *summa cum laude* at age 49 with a Doctor of Jurisprudence in 1991; and

17 WHEREAS, Guy J. Camuso Jr. passed the Georgia Bar Exam in 1992 and began practicing
18 in Gwinnett County, Georgia, as a general practitioner while still working full time with 3M;

20 WHEREAS, he was appointed to the first Gwinnett Veterans Treatment Court as a criminal
21 defense advisor by the Honorable Karen Beyers, Judge of the Superior Court of Gwinnett
22 County, in 2015, and he continues to serve in that capacity today; and

23 WHEREAS, he has been united in love and marriage for 57 years to his wife, Susan, and the
24 two have been blessed with three wonderful children and five remarkable grandchildren; and

25 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that Guy J. Camuso Jr. be appropriately
26 honored for his many outstanding accomplishments.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
28 the members of this body recognize and commend Guy J. Camuso Jr. and extend sincere best
29 wishes for success in all of his future endeavors.
